

REPORT ON COMPLETION OF THE ACTIVITY: HOUSEHOLD SURVEY AT 17 HIGH-PRIORITY VILLAGES of DAMPA LANDSCAPE, MIZORAM.

The household survey has been completed for 17 high-priority villages that have been identified for the initial level of implementation of project activities in the Dampa landscape, Mizoram. The Household survey falls under project output 2.1.1, - Social and BD Assessment. The sample size for the survey is estimated based on the 2011 census data for Mizoram. According to Village Profile & Development Indicators 2017-2018 published by the Directorate of Economics & Statistics Govt of Mizoram, there are 4696 households in high-priority areas, and out of these, 356 households (HHs) were taken for the survey. The sample size for the villages is given below.

The survey data consisting of 356 samples for all 17 villages are already uploaded in the Management and Information (MIS) of the Green-Ag. According to the survey and the data gathered, men comprise 73% of respondents, while women make up 27%. The Household survey was conducted in all 17 high-priority villages, with their sampling sizes as listed below:
