MINUTES OF THE FIFTH TECHNICAL SUPPORT GROUP (TSG) MEETING, GREEN LANDSCAPE IMPLEMENTATION UNIT (GLIU), MAMIT GREEN - AG PROJECT

Venue: DC Conference Hall, Mamit **Dated**:17th February,2023 at 11:00 am

The meeting starts at 11:00 am with a welcome speech from the Deputy Commissioner, Mamit. The Chairman thanked all the members for attending the 5th TSG meeting.

Project status and Activity report was given by Mr. Zokhuma Varte, District Agriculture Officer and Member Secretary of the TSG as given below: -

Project status and Activity Report (17 August 2022-14 February 2023): -

The Project status and activities implemented between the 4th TSG meeting which was held on 3rd August 2022 till today are given as below: -

- 1. FPIC process was conducted in 17 villages and consent had been signed with all the villages. Documentation is ongoing.
- 2. Trainings on Household Survey App were given to CRPs during 29th and 30th August, 2022. House Hold survey has been carried out in tablet mode and is completed for Lunglei District.
- 3. Training on Community Consultation for preparing Green Landscape Management Plan was given to GLIU experts by NPMU, and eventually the CRPs were given the training by GLIU experts. Community Consultation Program was carried out during 18th and 19th October 2022 at the cluster level. The 17 villages were divided in 6 clusters, 5 clusters in Mamit District and 1 cluster under Lunglei District. Consolidated report has been submitted to NPMU and awaits further TSG's approval.
- 4. Curriculum Development Workshop on Sustainable Agriculture was held on 16th November 2022 in Aizawl, together with Officials from the Line Department. Draft curricula on Sustainable Agriculture were prepared for Mizo chilli, Sticky rice and Winter Vegetables.
- 5. Training on Post Harvest Management of Mizo Chilli was given to CRPs by KVK in collaboration with GLIU experts on 30th November 2022. The CRPs further imparts training in 13 villages.
- 6. In collaboration with Environment, Forest and Climate Change Department, Govt. of Mizoram, the CRPs have undertaken the initiative in 2 villages in Mamit District for the Fire Prevention Week which was held during 6-11 February, 2023.

The Chairman invited Mrs. Lalchhuanawmi Pachuau, Team Leader, GLIU, Green-Ag Project who gave an elaborated power point presentation on the Green Landscape Management Plan (GLMP, 2023 - 24), Draft Annual Workplan & Budget (2023-24) & Action Plan for February to June, 2023.

The discussion points are as below:

- 1. Preparation of training materials on Vermicomposting for training of the beneficiaries will be done in coordination with KVK Lunglei. (Action KVK, Green Ag project)
- 2. Mrs. Lalremsangpuii, District Fisheries Development Officer, Fisheries Department informed the meeting that regarding mobilization of Eco Clubs to promote Green Landscape Conservation, Fisheries Department had Riverine Conservation Scheme with which convergence can be done. (Action Fishery Department, Green Ag Project)
- 3. The Line Departments were requested to be conscious about the GLMP activity/intervention and its timeline of implementation, and to provide the Government contribution part in time, so that the GLMP could be implemented according to its timeline. (Action All Line Department)
- 4. Dr. F. Vanlalruata, District Veterinary Officer, informed the meeting that since there is no Artificial Insemination Facility in our Project Landscape and utmost care is necessary for successful this process and hence for time being it will be better not to takeup these activities as of now. He also mentioned that regarding Pig Breeding Unit round table conversation with Veterinary Department should be conducted. (Action A.H. & Vety Department, Green Ag Project)
- 5. Mr. R.L. Peka, District Horticulture Officer suggested the meeting that for winter vegetables regarding selection of varieties it will be beneficial if horticulture department is consulted. (Action Horticulture, Green Ag Project)
- 6. The Chairman instructed that utmost importance should be given to road connectivity of the Project landscape. The line department should take action with budget available for link road construction with the department and give priority to construct and improve their Agriculture link road. (Action All Line Department)
- 7. The meeting was also informed that in VIC Meeting Line Departments Field Staffs were not active in attending the meeting, so all the Head of Departments were requested to instruct their Field Staffs to actively participated in VIC Meetings. (Action All Line Department)
- 8. Mr. J.D. Traite, SDM, NABARD informed the meeting that number of works and projects can be carried out under NABARD and instructed the Project to approach them for convergence. (Action NABARD, Green Ag Project)

9. The meeting was also informed that the Green-Ag Project is going to face Mid-term Review in the month of April, 2023. The line departments were requested to adhere to the GLMP timeline, so that the target would be achieved in time before Mid-term Review. (Action - All Line Department, Green Ag Project)

The GLMP (2023-24), Draft AWP&B (2023-24) and Action Plan (February to June 2023) was approved by the meeting after discussion.
