## Minutes of the Third State Steering Committee (SSC) Meeting of the FAO-GEF (6) assisted Green- Ag Project- Odisha

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3<sup>rd</sup> State Steering Committee (SSC) meeting of the FAO-GEF (6) assisted Green- Ag Project, Odisha was held under the Chairmanship of Sri Sanjeev Chopra, IAS, Agriculture Production Commissioner cum ACS, Odisha at 11.00 AM on 6<sup>th</sup> June 2022 at Krushi Bhawan, Bhubaneswar, Odisha. The List of participants is at **Annexure-A**.

At the outset, Director, Soil Conservation and WD cum State Project Nodal Officer, Green-Ag Project, Odisha welcomed the chairman and committee members as well as other participating officers. Dr. Konda Chavva Reddy, Asst FAO Representative in India made a presentation on the overview of Green-Ag project.

The Committee deliberated on agenda wise points and following decisions were made.

1. Approval of the minutes of 2<sup>nd</sup> State Steering Committee Meeting.

Minutes of the 2<sup>nd</sup> SSC meeting circulated to all members vide Letter No. 8586 dated. 15.11.2021 were approved as no comments have been received from any quarter.

2. Approval of Annual Work Plan & Budget (AWP&B) for the FY 2022 - 2023.

The Annual Work Plan & Budget for Year-4 (2022-23) amounting to Rs.4,98,82,090/was presented in the meeting. The AWPB for Year-4 has been prepared based on the Risk Management Plan and revised time line. The AWP&B Year- 4 was approved. The approved AWP&B-PY-4 (2022-23) is given at Annexure - I & II.

3. Approval of the Procurement Plan FY (2022 – 2023)

The procurement plan for procurement of goods and services to operationalize the AWPB Year – 4 as prepared by SPMU in consultation with NPMU for USD 39,864 (Rs.30.49 lakhs) was approved which is at *Annexure-III*.

4. TA/ DA & lodging provisions for SPMU and GLIU staff of Green-Ag Project

The proposal for provisioning of TA/DA and lodging for SPMU and GLIU team members as recommended by SLTC was approved which is at *Annexure – IV (A&B)*.

5. Approval of two topics of studies recommended by 4<sup>th</sup> SLTC during the AWP&B (2021-22).

The following two topics recommended by SLTC were approved.

- Assessment of water yield ecosystem services affecting agriculture practices and on farm livelihoods in Similipal Tiger Landscape, Odisha
- ii. Studies on ITK and BD conservation

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6. Approval for undertaking two more studies during the Annual Work Plan and Budget Period (2022-23).

Proposal for undertaking two more studies for the Financial Year 2022-23 were also approved. SLTC has been authorised to identify two relevant studies aligned with project objectives.

 Approval of topics for two State Policy Dialogues for the AWP&B period (2021-22)

The following two topics, which were recommended by SLTC for AWPB Year - 2021-22, were approved.

i. State Policy dialogue on Agrobiodiversity Conservation and promotion of indigenous varieties.

ii. State Policy dialogue on promotion and conservation of indigenous livestock breeds.

8. Approval for two policy dialogues during the Annual Work Plan and Budget Period (2022-23).

Proposal for undertaking two more policy dialogues for the Financial Year 2022-23 were also approved. SLTC has been authorised to identify and recommend two relevant policy dialogues aligned with Project Objectives.

9. Enhancement of monthly remuneration of Animal Husbandry Expert, GLIU.

The proposal of enhancing monthly remuneration of Animal Husbandry Expert, GLIU from Rs.40,000/- p.m to Rs.50,000/- p.m; as recommended by SLTC was discussed. It was decided to increase the monthly remuneration of Animal Husbandry Expert to Rs 55,000/- per month to attract candidates for the assignment.

- 10. Any other discussion as opined by the Chair.
- Mr R.B. Sinha, National Project Director, NPMU / FAO, Green-Ag Project opined that since the project is being implemented around forest protected area & the project needs support from competent authorities on day to day basis; therefore, the Chief Wild Life Warden, Odisha be a member of the State Steering Committee, which was accepted by the committee.
- Further Mr R.B. Sinha, National Project Director, NPMU / FAO; Green-Ag Project suggested that prompt actions need to be taken at the Operational Partner i.e. IMAGE level for timely accomplishment of the assignments. The Chairman directed Director, IMAGE to personally look into the matter for timely disposal of the cases relating to Green-Ag Project.

The meeting ended with vote of thanks to the Ghair & all participating members.
