





Minutes of the 3rd Technical Support Group (TSG) Meeting of Green-Ag Project, Odisha held on 20.07.2022, 11:30AM at

Facilitation Centre of Collectorate, Baripada, Mayurbhanj

3rd Technical Support Group (TSG) meeting of the Green-Ag Project, Odisha was held under the Chairmanship of Shri Vineet Bharadwaj, IAS, Collector and District Magistrate, Mayurbhanj -cum-Chairman, TSG, Green- Ag Project at 11:30 AM on 20th July 2022 in the Facilitation Centre of Collectorate, Mayurbhanj. Members and Nodal Officers from different line departments and from various institutes including, Agriculture, Horticulture, Fisheries, Sericulture, Forest, ITDA, PD, DRDA, Animal Husbandry participated in the meeting. Director, Soil Conservation and Watershed Development, Govt. of Odisha, Project Director, Green-Ag. Project, D.F.O. Karanjia and NPMU team joined the meeting through virtual mode. The list of participants is at **Annexure-1**.

At the outset, Mr. Bhabani Shankar Kalo, Project Director, Watersheds cum District Project Nodal Officer (DPNO), Mayurbhanj, Odisha of Green-Ag Project welcomed the Chairman and committee members of TSG as well as other participating officers. He gave a brief overview of the Green-Ag Project.

Subsequently, Mr. Sukanta Kumar Samal, State Technical Coordinator, SPMU made a detailed presentation on agenda items including findings of Geospatial analysis and secondary literature review for identification of high priority areas .

The Committee deliberated on agenda wise points and following decisions were made:

1. Action Taken Report on the recommendations of 2nd TSG Meeting:

The actions taken based on the minutes of the 2nd TSG meeting are as follows:

- (a) The circular will be issued for VIC formation to the various line departments through the office of the Chairman, TSG.
- (b) Two field study topics as proposed in the 2nd TSG were approved by the SSC.
- (c) High Priority areas have been identified on the basis of the findings of Geospatial analysis and the secondary literature review.
- (d) A district level inception workshop was held for better coordination, convergence and cooperation among various line departments.
- (e) The district level inception workshop also witnessed the participation from Sriram Chandra Bhanja Deo University and the university is being approached for development of Spatial Decision Support System.

2. Approval of the minutes of second Technical Support Group Meeting:

Minutes of the 2nd Technical Support Group (TSG) meeting circulated to all members vide Letter No. 44 dated. 07.01.2022 were approved as no comments have been received from any quarter.

3. Approval of high priority areas:

Based on findings of Geospatial analysis and secondary literature review, 66 high priority villages of six blocks segregated in to five clusters were approved by the TSG. The project implementation will be initiated in these 66 villages out of 1650 villages of the Similipal landscape falling in 17 blocks. The list of priority villages is annexed at **Annexure II**

4. Appraisal about Annual Work Plan & Budget (AWP&B) for FY 2022-23

The Annual Work Plan & Budget for the Financial Year 2022-23 amounting to Rs. 4, 98, 82,090 Cr as approved in the 3rd SSC meeting was appraised before the TSG members. The AWP&B of FY 2022-23 is annexed at **Annexure-III**.

5. Discussion on proposing two studies before SLTC for taking up in financial Year 2022-23

Few indicative studies specified in the project document as follows were discussed and it was decided to propose the same before SLTC for identifying two relevant study topics to be undertaken in financial year 2022-23.

- Studies on local procurement for Social safety net programs.
- Studies on incentives for environment friendly agriculture
- Studies on Sustainable Energy Alternatives


6. Any other discussions as opined by the Chair.

- a. The line departments were advised to cooperate and work in synergy with the office of Project Director, Watersheds-cum- District Nodal officer, and Green-Ag for community level interventions on priority basis. The interventions must be in line with the need and consent of the target communities.

- b. The Chair advised the heads of line departments to work towards convergence of schemes aligned with project objectives whereas Green-Ag funds could be utilized as gap funds wherever required.
- c. The Chair advised for the convergence with MNREGS scheme.
- d. Interventions should be planned as per the need of the stakeholders.
- e. The Chair advised to hold regular inter departmental monitoring and review.














